"DO YOU NOT KNOW...? HAVE YOU NOT HEARD...?"

That God loves you?

"For God so loved the world that he gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes In Him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

"Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the Name of God's one and only Son" (John 3:18).

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him" (John 3:36).

"Yet to all who received Him, to those who believed in His Name, He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).

That Jesus died for our sins?

"But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities, the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed" (Is. 53:5).

"But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8).

"He was delivered over to death for our sins...." (Rom. 4:25).

That Jesus was raised to life for out justification?

"He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification" (Rom. 4:25).

That Jesus is Lord?

"That at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

And every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Phil. 2:10-11).

".....Christ died and returned to life so that He might be the Lord of both the dead and the living" (Rom. 14:9).

That Jesus is our Saviour?

"I (Jesus) am the way and the truth and the life. no man comes to the Father except through me" (John 14:6).

"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

"Since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through Him!" (Rom. 5:9).

That Jesus is our sufficiency?

"I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty" (John 6:35). "If you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask whatever you wish and it will be given you" (John 15:7).

That Jesus Christ is coming again?

".....This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven" (Acts 1:11).

That He is coming to judge the world?

"For the Son of Man is going to come in His Father's glory with His angels, and then He will reward each person according to what he has done" (Matt. 16:27).

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad" (2 Cor. 5:10).

"Behold, I (Christ) am coming soon! My reward is with Me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done" (Rev. 22:12).

That everyone will give an account of his deeds?

"For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil" (Eccl. 12:14).

"So then, each of us will give an account of himself to God (Rom. 14:12).

That the guilty will go to hell, and the righteous to eternal life?

"DO YOU NOT KNOW...? HAVE YOU NOT HEARD...?"

"Then He (Christ) will say to those on His left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels...." (Matt. 25:41).

"Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life" (Matt. 25:46).

That God, nevertheless, wants everyone to be saved?

"For I take no pleasure in the death of anyone', declares the Sovereign Lord. 'Repent and live'" (Ezek. 18:32).

".....God our Saviour, who wants all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth". (1 Tim. 2:3-4).

That Christ is even now knocking on your door?

"Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me" (Rev. 3:20).

Now you have heard enough to know that God loves you and that He desires to save you from your sins, and give you eternal life through faith in Jesus Christ. Today, Christ Himself stands at the door of your heart knocking and waiting to be let in. if you let Him, He will come in with the power of the Holy Spirit, and transform you into a brand new freedom. Confess all your sins to God now, and say the following prayer aloud, sincerely meaning every word of it: -

Father in heaven, I declare today, O Lord, that I believe in my heart:

- That Jesus Christ is the Son of God.
- That he died for my sins.
- That God raised Him from the dead for my justification.
- That He is returning soon to judge the world.

Lord Jesus Christ, I accept you into my life as my personal Lord and Saviour. Deliver me from the bondage, and fill me with the Holy Spirit. Help me stand firm in the faith to the end, so that I will live and reign with you in glory.

Thank You, Lord Jesus, for saving me. Amen.

You are saved, you are born again, and you are a new child of God. However, there are a few things you must do:

- You must be baptized (immersed) in water.
- Read (study) the Bible daily.
- You must pray every day, and often during the day.
- You must share the good news of salvation with others regularly.
- You must give of your time and substance as an offering to God, and for the spread of the gospel.
- You must fellowship with other believers on a regular basis.

May the Lord richly bless you in Jesus Name. Amen.
