DEAR KIVI PARTNERS

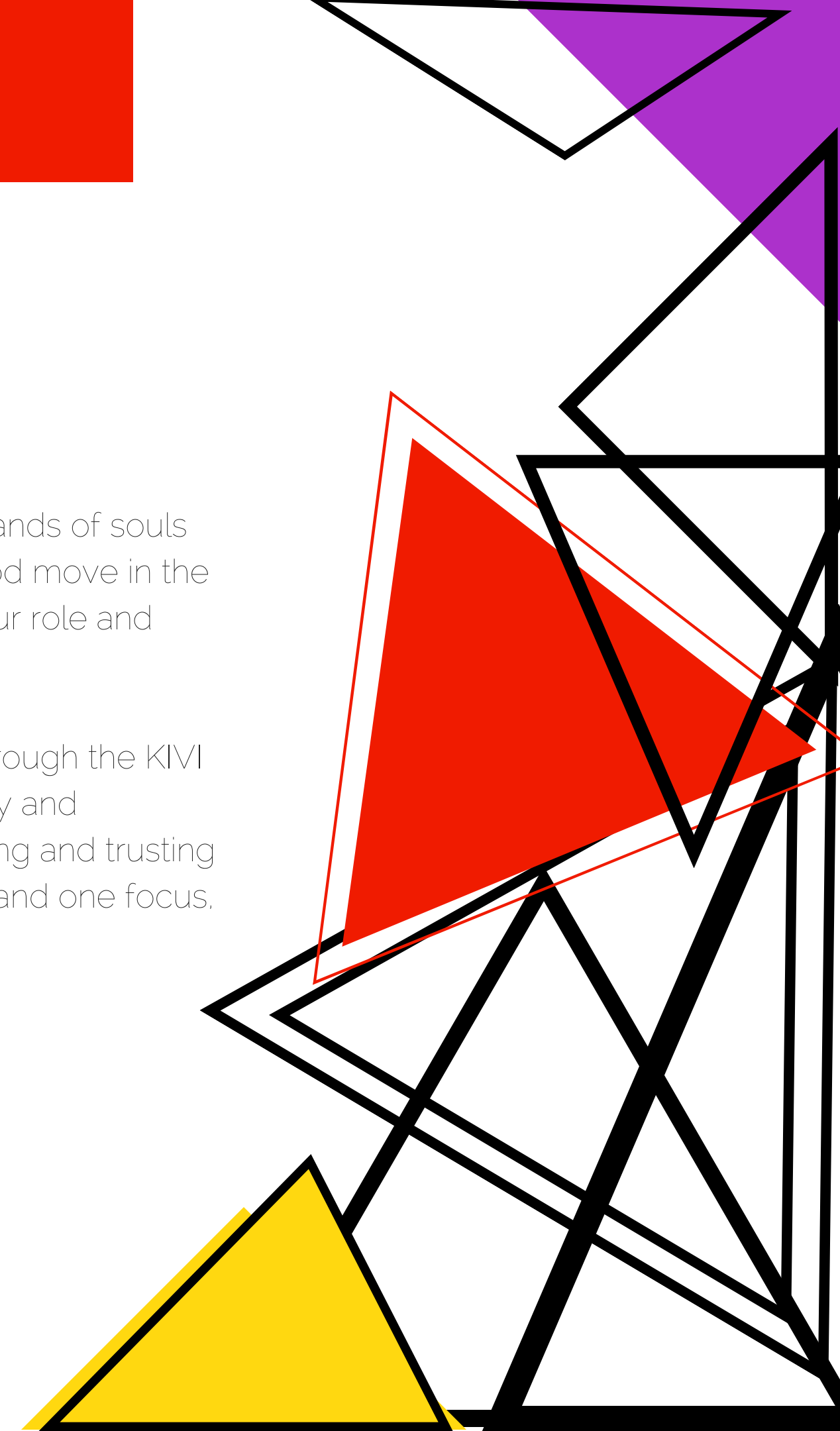

19 - 24 JULY 2016

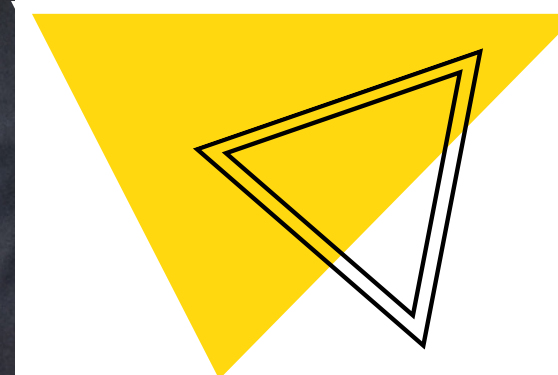

This was a 5 days outreach in which we had a great encounter with God and saw many people saved. The outreach was centred around the area of Jacmel close to the Haitian capital of Port Au Prince. Throughout the outreach we experienced an awesome time of praise and worship with 2-3 thousand people, including many young people in attendance. We saw healings, deliverances and many who gave their lives to Christ.

KASHIPUR & BARISAL BANGLADESH

28-29 OCTOBER 2016

We give all glory and honour to the Lord God Almighty. For the first time, KIVI Bangladesh conducted an outreach for 2 days and at 2 different locations, Kashipur and Barisal on 28-29 October 2016. As with previous outreaches, the KIVI team worked closely with pastors and local churches in preparation for the outreaches. The saints united in prayer, fasting and the provision of financial support and our God was, as always, faithful. The result was a wonderful time of fellowship, where the gospel was preached with power, authority, courage and boldness.





We thank God and those who have partnered together to see: 519 precious souls saved at Kashipur. Out of 1000+ who attended. And 283 precious souls were saved, at Barisal out of the 400+ people who attended. A grand total of 812 souls who have joined the population of heaven. Indeed there was much rejoicing in heaven over these new souls. We have seen the mighty hand of God move with: the lame walking instantly, the deaf hearing, people with back pain healed instantly by our miracle working God.

When we take one step for God, He takes care of the rest.



AJANGBADI, LAGOS NIGERIA

4-5 NOVEMBER 2016

The second edition of the KIVI Ajangbadi soul winning crusade held 4th - 5th Nov. 2016 in Ajangbadi, Lagos Nigeria. Over 15 churches in KIVI Nigeria came together to organise the Outreach which featured 3 guest ministers: Apostle Edwin Debebs from Bayelsa, Evang. Dapo from KIVI UK and Evang. Junior from KIVI UK. The turnout was impressive as many came to receive healing, deliverance, and salvation, and the power of God was evidently present as over 40 people gave their lives to Christ Jesus and there was an outbreak of deliverance. Despite many challenges like finance, the crusade held and we give God the glory for everyone he used - KIVI Bangladesh and KIVI UK assisted with T-Shirts and finances respectively. Apostle Edwin Debebs of Campaign for Christ, Yenegoa Bayelsa State Nigeria was commissioned to extend the frontiers of KIVI in Bayelsa.

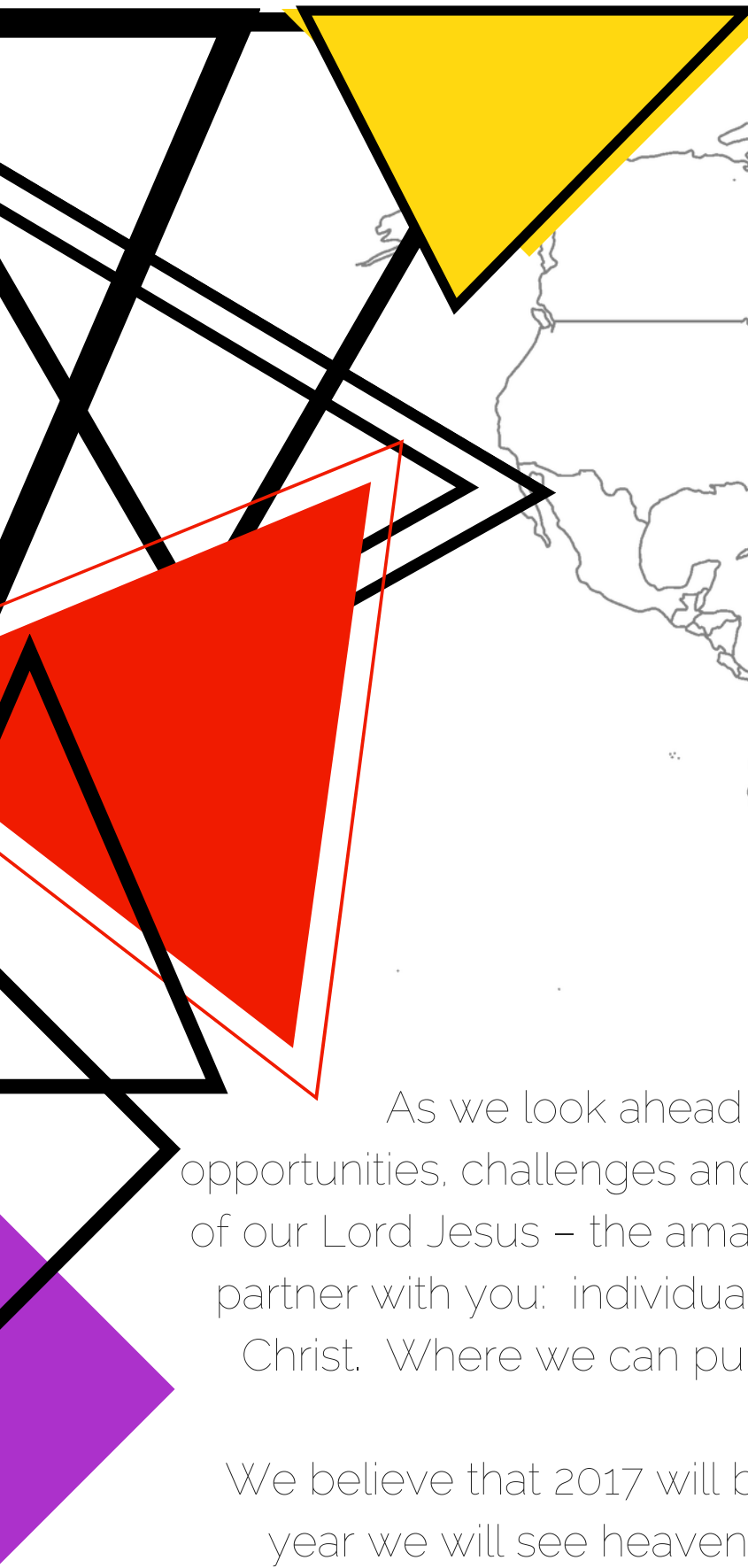
OTHER ENDEAVOURS - MISSIO DEI

BRAZIL SEPTEMBER 2016

The team spent four days and three nights sleeping on a boat travelling on the River Negra and the River Solimoes ministering in different villages and churches. They spent time ministering to the Tatuyo Tribe. Ministered in 4 high-security prisons over three days, where many gave their lives to Christ and we were able to minister to many on a 1 to 1 basis. Spent a full day at a drug rehabilitation centre (affiliated with Teen Challenge) where they had time to interact, lead a Bible study and pray together. They also spent a day in the very deprived jungle areas of Sao Sabastio and Acatuba - where the team visited many families in their homes, encouraged and prayed with them. Bringing over 9 suitcases of clothing to distribute to many people

Thank you for financial donations received, the team were able to buy around 90 food bags and 200 Bibles to distribute to those in need during the trip. 'Ray of Hope' provided reading glasses to many people. One man aged 72 was overjoyed when he received the glasses and said that he can now read his bible without the words all jumbled together! Spent 2 days in Manacapuru and visited a school - lunch at school for some pupils would be their only meal of the day. Ministered to people on the street, in homes and churches in the city of Manaus God opened new doors.

“Don't read on!! Close your eyes and think of three reasons Evangelists should work together.

What did you think of? Shared skills/resource/bigger crowd? Here is the main reason: Authority. "[Jesus] called his twelve disciples together and began sending them out two by two, giving them authority to cast out evil spirits." (Mark 6:7).

“Winning souls is, essentially, the process of evangelizing or witnessing, which is simply communicating the message of salvation to unbelievers. Jesus Christ told His followers they would be His witnesses to "the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8) and to "go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19), which is the essence of winning souls. As our Father in heaven does not want anyone to perish (2 Peter 3:9), all Christians should be eager to heed this call and have a passion for winning souls.

Witnessing, however, is less about what we do for the Lord as it is about what He does through us, and this requires a surrendered heart filled with the Holy Spirit. Indeed, the same Holy Spirit who empowered Christ while He was ministering on earth can empower us as well. First, however, we need to understand our role in building the body of Christ. As the apostle Paul explained to those in Corinth, we are God's servants who work in unity with one another to produce a harvest. One will plow the soil, another may plant the seed, and another laborer will water it, but only God can make that seed grow (1 Corinthians 3:7).

But how can we gain a passion for spreading this good news and winning souls to Christ in these difficult days when there are so many who oppose our work every step of the way? It starts by having Jesus Christ front and center in our own lives. Indeed, our passion for winning souls will increase as our passion for Christ Himself and our walk with Him become stronger. Two of the best ways to strengthen our Christian walk are to read His Word daily and to pray continually.”

IN CRISIS CHRIST IS...

Life is full of unforeseen circumstance, pain and struggles. In fact, some rightly believe that life is all about problem-solving. You overcome one hurdle to face the next challenge. Though this can be a thrilling adventure, it can also be very challenging and things can go horribly wrong. We are all bound in by history and we all remember the 'Crisis? What Crisis?' said David Blunkett, the former Education Secretary. These three words: 'Crisis? What Crisis?' according to a BBC report helped bring down the Jim Callaghan's Labour government in 1979, during the Winter of Discontent. The first question is: What is crisis? It's a time of intense difficulty or danger.

A time when one feels like being caught between the rock and

the hard place. There are many types of crisis we can all face in life. These include 'emergency' crisis such as natural disasters, disease epidemics; 'man-made' crisis such economic, conflicts and wars; and 'personal life' crisis such as identity, confidence, loss of income, a source of livelihood and relationship breakdown. A time of life crisis certainly can leave one feeling that everything is slipping out of control. It can lead to some people feeling life is not worth living anymore. Many turn to the wrong things such as excessive drinking, smoking or taking illicit drugs. Sadly some people, in particular men find times of crisis too difficult that they decide to end it all by committing suicide. In 1981, it was reported that twice

the number (4,129) of men as women in the UK took their own lives. This number had risen to 4,590 in 2012. The suicide rate for men is now three and a half times that of women. Life crisis affects a person in many ways mentally, psychologically and emotionally. This advice from the US Actor, Edward Albert is helpful "In times of life crisis, whether wildfires or smouldering stress, the first thing I do is go back to basics... am I eating right, am I getting enough sleep, am I getting some physical and mental exercise every day." However, why carry the burden alone when someone more powerful loves you and right there waiting to help you deal with the crisis. Why not put Christ in your crisis?

Listen to what He says to you: "Come to me, all of you who are tired and have heavy loads, and I will give you rest. 29 Accept my teachings and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in spirit, and you will find rest for your lives". – Matthew 11:28-29. Dear friend no matter the crisis crushing you down Christ can carry you through to a more desirable end. My advice to you is "Give all your worries to him because he cares about you." – 1 Peter 5:7.
